PRICE SENSITIVE INFORMATION RESULTS OF OUR CONTROLLING SHAREHOLDER, LAS VEGAS SANDS CORP., FOR ITS FISCAL FOURTH QUARTER AND FULL YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER, 2009

This announcement is issued pursuant to Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited.

On or about February 17, 2010 (1.30 p.m. Pacific standard time), our controlling shareholder, Las Vegas Sands Corp. (“LVSC”), announced its financial results for its fiscal fourth quarter and full year ended December 31, 2009.

At the request of the Company, trading in the shares of the Company was suspended with effect from 10:00 a.m. on 18 February, 2010 pending the release of this announcement. Application has been made to The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited for the resumption of trading in the shares of the Company with effect from 2:30 p.m. on 18 February, 2010.

This announcement is issued by Sands China Ltd. (“we” or our “**Company**”) pursuant to Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited.

Our Company’s controlling shareholder, LVSC, is a company listed on the New York Stock Exchange (the “**NYSE**”) in the United States. As at the date of this announcement, LVSC beneficially owns approximately 70.3% of the issued and outstanding share capital of our Company.

LVSC files quarterly and annual reports, including quarterly and annual financial information and certain operating statistics under Form 10-Q and Form 10-K, respectively, with the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (the “**SEC**”), in accordance with the ongoing disclosure obligation applicable to a publicly traded NYSE-listed company. Such filings include segment financial information about the Macao operations of LVSC, which Macao operations are owned by our Company, and the filings are available in the public domain.

LVSC has, on or about February 17, 2010 (1.30 p.m. Pacific standard time), announced its financial results for the fiscal fourth quarter and full year ended 31 December, 2009 (the “**Quarterly Financial Results**”) and held its Fourth Quarter 2009 Earnings Conference Call (the “**Earnings**”).

The financial results of LVSC and its consolidated subsidiaries, including those contained in the Quarterly Financial Results and Earnings Call, have been prepared in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles of the United States (“**US GAAP**”), which are different from the International Financial Reporting Standards (“**IFRS**”) that we use to prepare and present our financial results and related financial information. As such, the financial results and related information set forth in the Quarterly Financial Results and Earnings Call is not directly comparable to the financial results and related financial information that our Company discloses as a company listed on the Main Board of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited. In particular, Average Daily Rate (“**ADR**”) and Revenue Per Available Room (“**RevPAR**”) as presented in the Quarterly Financial Results and Earnings Call are based on gross room revenues as reported under US GAAP, which include associated promotional allowances within room revenues. Under US GAAP, promotional allowances are then deducted from total gross revenues in presenting net revenues. Under IFRS, room revenues exclude such promotional allowances. Our shareholders and potential investors in our securities should consult their own professional advisers for an understanding of the differences between IFRS and US GAAP. Our shareholders and potential investors in our securities are further advised that the financial results and related financial information set forth in the Quarterly Financial Results and Earnings Call with respect to our Company’s operating results have not been prepared or presented by our Company, and there is no indication or assurance from our Company that the financial results and related financial information of our Company will be the same as that presented in the Quarterly Financial Results and Earnings Call.

EXTRACTS OF LVSC’S QUARTERLY FINANCIAL RESULTS

The Venetian Macao Fourth Quarter Operating Results

The Venetian Macao delivered a quarterly record of US\$174.7 million in adjusted property EBITDAR for the fourth quarter of 2009. Gaming volumes at The Venetian Macao were strong during the quarter, with year-over-year increases in each segment of the casino. Slot handle increased 15.2% compared to the quarter one year ago, while Non-Rolling table drop at The Venetian Macao continued to lead the market at US\$904.6 million for the quarter. Rolling Volume play increased 18.0% during the quarter to US\$10.0 billion, with the direct play portion increasing to approximately 16.8% of that total.

Sands Macao Fourth Quarter Operating Results

Sands Macao's fourth quarter operating performance reflected solid gaming volumes with adjusted property EBITDAR increasing to US\$56.4 million in the quarter, an increase of 7.8% compared to the fourth quarter of 2008. EBITDAR margin decreased to 19.8% in the quarter, compared to 21.2% in the year-ago quarter. The quarter's results reflected an increase in reserves for slower paying customers of US\$12.4 million during the fourth quarter of 2009, compared to the fourth quarter of 2008. Sands Macao gaming volumes remain healthy across the board, including slot handle which was up 39.6% compared to the same quarter last year, and continue to reflect the strong market positioning of the Sands Macao on the Macao peninsula.

Four Seasons Hotel Macao and Plaza Casino Fourth Quarter Operating Results

The Four Seasons Hotel Macao and Plaza Casino delivered US\$20.4 million of adjusted property EBITDAR for the fourth quarter, an increase of US\$15.8 million, or 343%, compared to US\$4.6 million during the prior year quarter. Net revenue for the property was US\$97.8 million during the fourth quarter, with casino revenues representing US\$77.4 million of that total. The property's performance benefited from the first full quarter of its Paiza mansion suite offerings, which drove healthy Rolling Chip volume of US\$3.75 billion during the quarter. Rolling Chip win percentage for the quarter was 2.12%, below our expected Rolling Chip win percentage of 3.0%. Approximately 29% of that Rolling Chip play was generated in our higher-margin direct rolling program. The mass gaming business at the Four Seasons Hotel Macao and Plaza Casino continued to grow during the quarter with US\$79.7 million in slot handle, an increase of US\$49.4 million, or 163.0%, over last year's quarter, while Non-Rolling Chip table games drop was US\$85.2 million. Hotel occupancy reached nearly 70%, up from approximately 32% in the same quarter last year.

EARNINGS CALL EXTRACTS

Mr. Sheldon G. Adelson, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of LVSC, announced that the first phase of the development of Parcels 5 and 6 “will open in June 2011, around 16 months from today. The second phase of the development will open approximately six months thereafter, and will feature an additional 2,300 rooms from the Sheraton Towers brand.”

Mr. Michael Leven, President and Chief Operating Officer of LVSC, announced that “The direct VIP play at The Venetian Macao grew to US\$1.7 billion, or approximately 17% of the more than US\$10 billion of rolling volume during the quarter. At the Four Seasons Hotel Macao and Plaza Casino, which is clearly benefitting from our 19 Paiza mansions, rolling volume grew impressively to US\$3.8 billion, while direct VIP business accounted for US\$1.1 billion, or 29% of that amount”.

Mr. Michael Leven further commented that “The operating momentum of our Macau properties continued in January of this year (2010), with strong year-over-year growth despite the fact that Chinese New Year fell in January last year.”

Mr. Kenneth J. Kay, Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of LVSC, announced that “For the Venetian Macao Restricted Group at December 31, 2009, our trailing twelve months EBITDA for compliance purposes was US\$940 million, total gross debt at the Venetian Macao Restricted Group was US\$2.6 billion dollars, and our leverage ratio was 2.81:1.0, compared to a maximum leverage covenant of 4.5:1.0”.

Please see below further highlights from the Questions and Answers session of the Earnings Call:

- in respect of Macau, there was an approximate 20% reserve for doubtful accounts against the gross accounts receivable of the casino business; and
- the Apart-Hotel Tower could have a value in excess of US\$1 billion and the Company is considering various options in order to realize the value of this asset.
